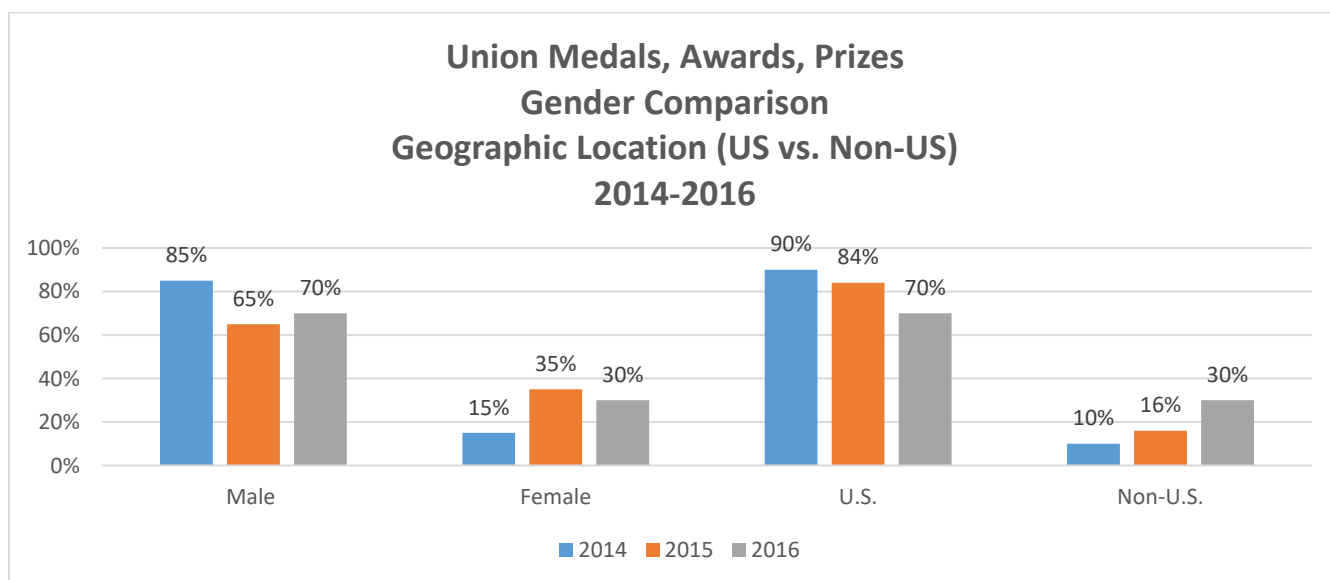

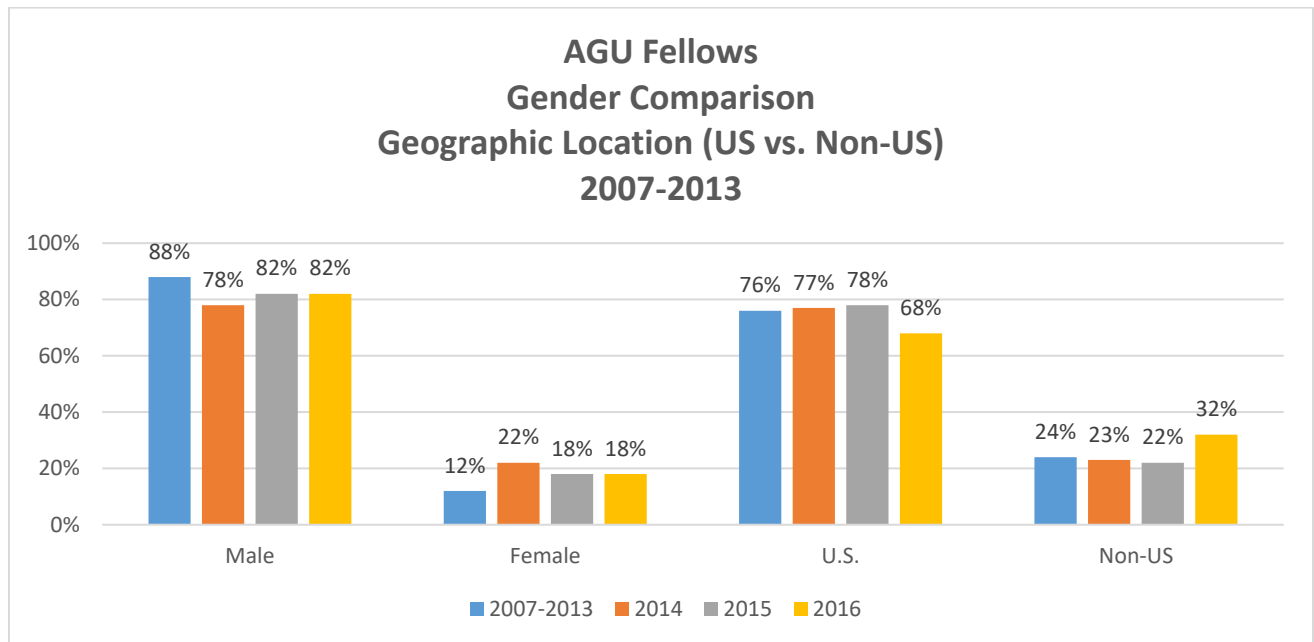

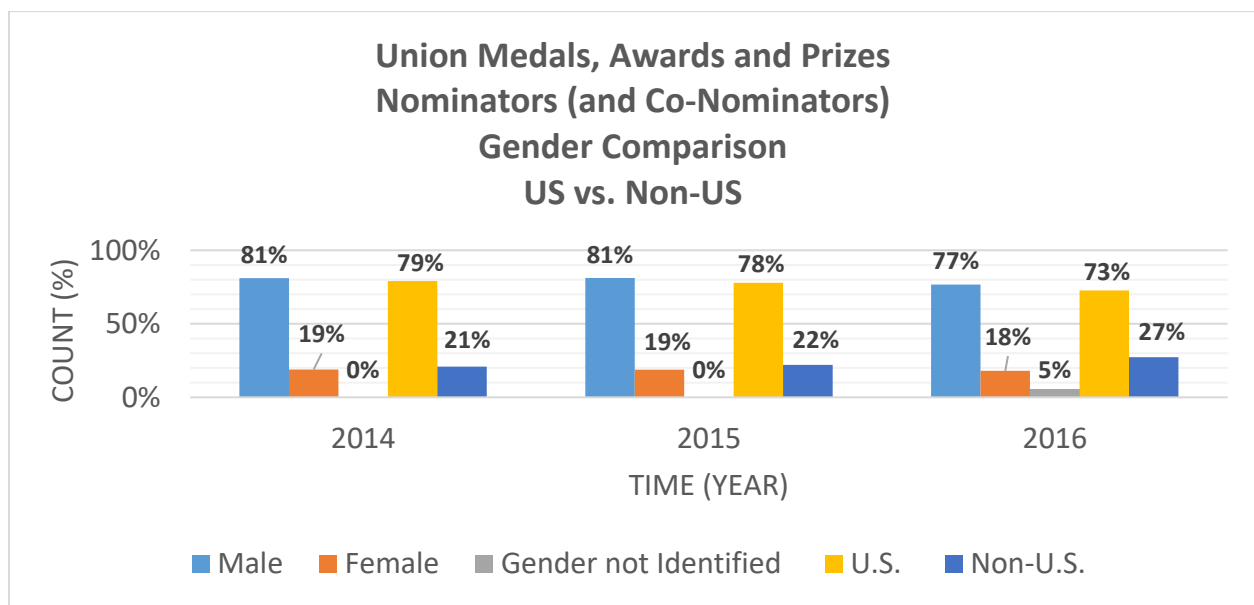

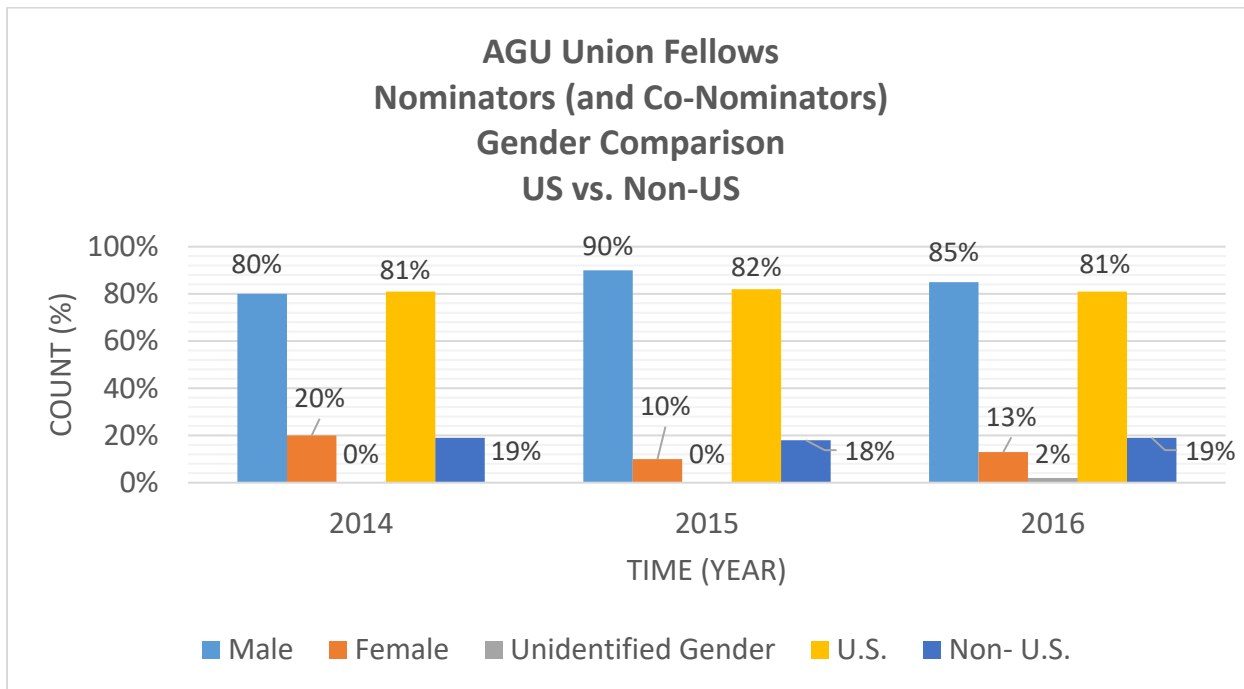
Demographics for 2016 Honors Cycle



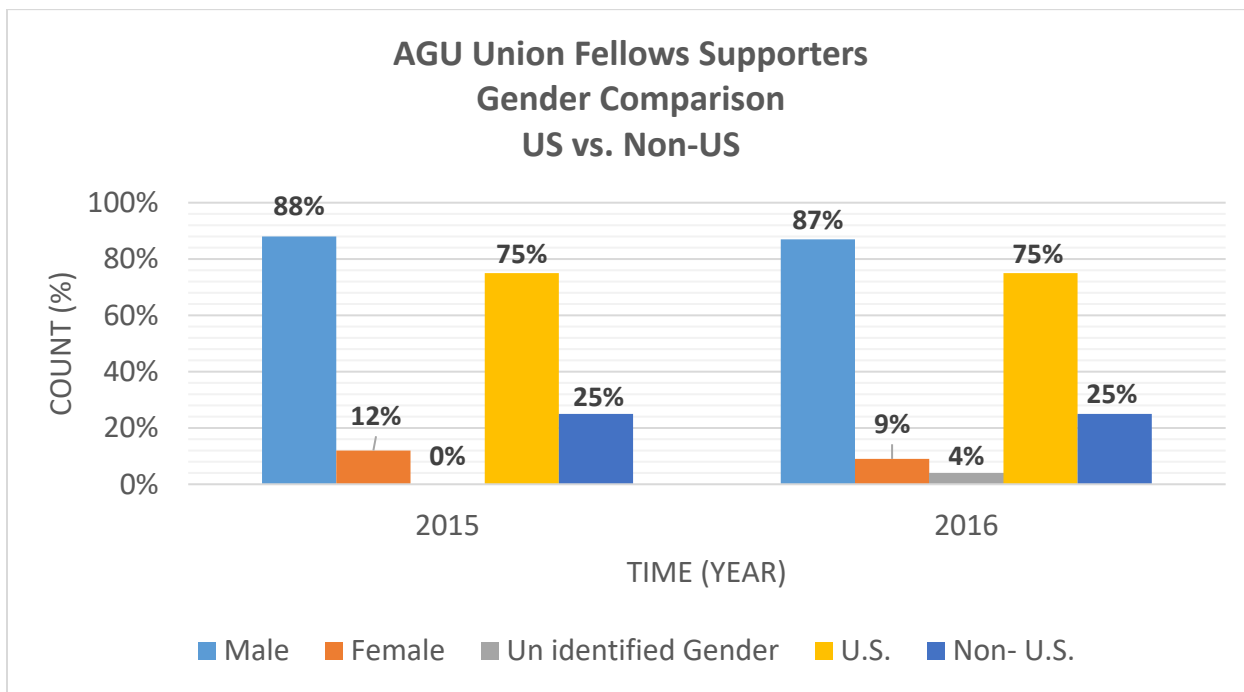
Comparative Data – Nominators
